

What is Character?

Character can be defined in a variety of ways:

- The inward motivation to do what is right
- Who you are, even when no one is watching
- The key to true success in every area of life



Who is this workshop for?

This workshop is for children, aged 5 years and above. It is specially designed to teach them the character trait of SELF-CONTROL from a biblical perspective.

What you will learn

In this workshop, the children will learn about SELF-CONTROL which can be defined as 'rejecting my own desires and doing what is right'. Self control helps children win a most crucial battle, the battle to master themselves. There are five aspects of self-control:

- Not to act impulsively
- Not to equate desires with rights
- Setting your own limits
- Seeing anger as a sign that something is wrong
- Walking away from things that are not right
